- each regional chess federation has the right to nominate any number of teams which are called A, B etc.

- participation of foreign regional representation after organizer's agreement possible

- Swiss system of 7 rounds, 2 x 25 min.

- financial prizes in CZK\*: 5 000, 3 000, 2 000 (10 000 altogether)

- material prizes for other teams

- teams registered before 8.9. 2006 have free start, other teams pay 4 EUR

#### E) 24.9. 2006 Open tournament in active chess

- players without age and performance limitations, Swiss system of 7 rounds, 2 x 15 min.

- financial prizes in CZK\*: 1 500, 1 000, 500

- financial prizes for other players

- starting fee:

- GM, IM, WGM and WIM have free start

- youngsters up to 18 years of age, players over 65 years of age and women 2 EUR

- other players 4 EUR

A and B tournaments - 1. number of points, 2. in case of dividing the 1<sup>st</sup> place or dividing progressing place, better result in mutual games among players who it is concerned about, provided all mutual games were played, 3. middle Buchholz, 4. Buchholz, 5. assessment according to the Sonnenborn-Berger system, 6. Progressive score, 7. lot.

C and E tournaments -1. number of points, 2. Buchholz, 3. middle Buchholz, 4. average ELO of rivals, 5. lot, financial prizes are distributed according to Hort system among such number of players which corresponds to number of advertised prizes

D tournament - 1. sum of points obtained on individual chessboards (so-called Olympic system), 2. mutual game, 3. Buchholz, 4. middle Buchholz, 5. lot, prizes are distributed according to Hort system among three best teams
